## NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HALVERGATE) (EMERGENCY NOTICE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2021 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency waterworks the use by vehicles of Branch Road from its junction with March Road for a distance of 40 metres south in the PARISH OF HALVERGATE will be temporarily prohibited from 4<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to 10<sup>th</sup> February 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Marsh Road, Sandhole Road, The Street, Moulton Road, Halvergate Road, Reedham Road, Acle Road, New Road, A47 J A1064 Roundabout, A47 From Acle Parish Boundary To Halvergate Parish Boundary, A47 From J A12 To J A1064, Acle New Road, Branch Road (Beighton/ Halvergate/ Acle).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
