

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY – IMPORTANT UPDATE

It is with great regret that the Parish Council must announce further restrictions to this year's Wreath-Laying ceremony on Sunday 8 November.

Parishioners will probably know that a scaled-down event had been planned that the PC believed would have been compliant with Covid Tier 1 regulations then in force.

However, the tighter restrictions announced by the Prime Minister on 31 October (the "second lockdown") now additionally include the implementation of a strict "Test and Trace" policy, if the event is to proceed as planned. This would mean that the contact details from all those attending, even the most casual observers, would need to be collected. In view of the particular location of Halvergate War Memorial, it is felt that this could make it very difficult for organisers of the event to ensure it was fully Covid-compliant.

Please be assured that the sacrifices of the Fallen will be commemorated in as dignified and appropriate a manner as is possible in these unusual circumstances. However, given the complications presented the latest regulations mentioned above, **parishioners and others are specifically requested not to gather at the Halvergate War Memorial on this Remembrance Sunday.**
